



It is springtime in Cleveland and the construction is upon us once again. Waterloo Road is now one way heading west (opposite direction as last year), therefore, we recommend that everyone exit at the East 185th Street exit and head west on Villaview, which turns into Waterloo. Please see the maps below:

When coming from the west (heading east), get off on the E 185th exit. From the exit ramp, turn right onto E 185th and then a quick left onto Villaview Rd, which will turn into Waterloo and The Beachland is a couple miles down the road on the right.



When coming from the east (heading west), get off on the E 185th st exit. The exit ramp will turn into Villaview Rd, which will turn into Waterloo Rd and The Beachland will be on the right.



Although we recommend everyone use the East 185th street exit, East 152nd is still open. A detour is required. Please see map below.
